CURRICULUM UPDATE

Over the past month, teachers have been busy assessing and writing reports for students. We are currently in the editing and proof reading stage.

NAPLAN testing has been completed and this was the first year that students at Baxter P.S. completed the testing online. You may have read in the news that there were many issues with the online platform however we did not experience this and the testing schedule ran smoothly here.

We have recently completed the Professional Learning Communities (PLC) Initiative training. Our next challenge is to implement the recommendations from our training. We are currently in the planning stages for this.

Our Year 4-6 students have now completed the 'Attitudes to School' survey. We look forward to receiving our results as we value our student feedback.

Michelle Bremner and I recently attended a statewide Principal Forum. Notably a session with Professor John Hattie has given us a lot to think about in regards to what intervention strategies we implement at our school and will be the most effective in improving student learning.




Submit Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund (CSEF) applications

Applications for the 2019 CSEF remain open until the end of Term 2, on Friday 28 June.



The CSEF helps ensure all students are able to participate in school trips and sporting activities.

CSEF details

The fund provides a payment of \$125 for eligible primary school students and \$225 for eligible secondary school students paid directly to the school, to be used towards camps, sports and excursion costs for the benefit of the student. Families holding a valid means-tested concession card are eligible to apply, as well as certain students and families who fall into a special consideration category.

Payments to schools commenced from March this year; however, schools can still accept and process applications for the CSEF until the end of Term 2, on Friday 28 June.

Changes to the application process

Students who received CSEF at your school in 2018 do not need to reapply in 2019, unless there have been changes to family circumstances or they have changed schools.



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
